Workshop: "Collage from the Heart," Tuesday, March 20

Sign up at crafts @ bacsma.org for our upcoming workshop on collage making, led by **Linda Branch Dunn**, Tuesday, March 20, 1:00–3:30 pm, Flint Room, Town Center Building. A \$5 fee will be payable to the instructor.

From Linda's notes: "You will create a collage with personal meaning. You will learn how to develop your composition, build layers, and edit with color and pattern. Demos include the use of stencils, fabric, acrylic textures, and washes. The emphasis is on following where surprise leads you. You will go home with at least two small collages that resonate with your heart."

Please bring:

- Small collection (shoe box or manila envelope's worth) of interesting papers.
 Possibilities include tissue paper, sewing patterns, magazine/ book pages, sheet music, stamps, and junk envelopes.
 Look for an assortment of text, color, and pattern. You will cut these up, so make copies of anything you want to preserve or use again.
- Personal imagery. Choose one image, 3-5" on a side, with personal resonance: a photo, a drawing, or words. Make copies beforehand so that you feel free to experiment. Linda recommends three copies, 3-8" on a side. Black and white copies are fine.
- Scissors
- Pencil

Optional supplies:

- Ruler
- Rag(s) or paper towels
- One or two small brushes for acrylics
- Snack and something to drink

Linda will bring adhesives, coloring tools, and surprises.
