The basket is made of reed with seagrass trim and will stand about 7.5" on a side and about 3.5" tall. Learn to weave the base, sides, and basket rim, choosing from a variety of accent colors to decorate your basket.

There will be a half-hour break midway through and participants are encouraged to bring a bag lunch.
